



## Lex250 Patriots' Day Weekend April 19th, 2025 Accessibility Fact Sheet



The purpose of this document is to provide helpful information to the spectators planning to attend the **Reenactment, Rededication, and Parade during the Lexington 250th Celebration** events on **Saturday, April 19th, 2025**. For information not covered in this document, please refer to the Lex250 website, which can be found at the bottom of this page.

**Accessible Parking:** There will be 50 provided spaces for ADA parking at the Depot Lot located in downtown Lexington at [15 Edison Way](#). This is the closest available lot to the Battle Green and can be accessed along paved surfaces. These spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Additional parking can be found at [25 Hartwell Ave](#), which also serves as a dedicated accessible lot. Please see the following section for more information.

**Shuttle Service:** There is a dedicated accessible parking lot and shuttle service located at **25 Hartwell Ave, Lexington, MA**. This shuttle service will bring you from the parking lot to Worthen Road. The shuttle ride will be approximately five to ten minutes long, depending on traffic. The pick-up and drop-off area on Worthen Road is a short distance from the Battle Green.

**Viewing Area:** There is a designated area for ADA viewing at the Battle Green. It is located directly behind the Minute Man statue on the Mass Ave side. This area is first-come, first-served.

**ASL Services:** There will be an ASL interpreter for the Battle Green Rededication.

**Jumbotrons:** There will be three large jumbotrons located around the Battle Green area, which will provide additional viewpoints all day.

**Restrooms:** There will be ADA-compliant portable restrooms located throughout the celebration grounds. There will also be accessible portable restrooms at the shuttle lots. For a map, please [click here](#).
